Background

The Library Research Center has collected library data for decades, most notably:

- FSCS data for the state of Illinois
- Public Library Data Service for the Public Library Association
- Annual Survey for Association of College and Research Libraries

However....

...The Resulting Reports:

- **Are always static** – where data is presented in books or read-only file formats
- **Include only one data year** – which prohibits longitudinal comparisons
- **Geared towards ‘data experts’** – where the information needs of other types of users are not met

LRC's FSCS Data Tool

The FSCS Data Tool improves upon past data reporting efforts thanks to:

- Interactive, web-based display of data
- Inclusion of five year's worth of data (2000-2004)
- Functionality appealing to low- and high-level data users

Data Tool Features

- Five-year trends at national, regional, state, and library level
- Interactive database where users can customize, save, and export datasets meeting their own needs
- Library comparison group builder
- Customized PDF fact sheets for all FSCS reporting libraries

Why use the FSCS Data Tool?

Hypothesis Testing

Data coordinators and library administrators must process a great deal of data in order stay on top of policy and planning decisions.

But where does the analysis start?

The Trends feature of the FSCS Data Tool allows you to quickly narrow your focus.

Why use the FSCS Data Tool?

Library Comparisons

Monitoring library performance is important for state library administrators and library directors.

Library trends and the comparison group builder allow users to target their analysis on key library trends.

The interactive database can be used to find library groups based on different FSCS variables.

Why use the FSCS Data Tool?

Print-Ready Library Reports

When you need library information readily available for meetings or for future reference, the FSCS Data Tool offers printable reports at the state and library level.

PDF reports include State Fact sheets, library fact sheets, and library reports covering library income and expenditures, library services, and staffing and holding levels.

Why use the FSCS Data Tool?

Data Analysis Interface

Library administrators who are not comfortable with statistical software will find the interactive database allows them to run analyses without additional software.

Higher-level features include the ability to save and load saved sessions, generation of charts and cross tabs, and the calculation of new data columns.

What Does “Interactive” Mean?

FSCS variables are presented in an interactive format in which the user can perform the following functions:

- Sort, filter, order, and group data to compare their library
- Create their own charts and cross tabs
- Create customized variables based on their own calculations
- Save their progress and retrieve their session at a later time
- Export all data and new calculated values into Excel or CSV formats

Interactive Database Controls



By clicking here, the user can create new columns of data based on their own calculations.



This controls the table layout. Users can select which variables they do/do not want to see and reorder the variables.



This allows users to place a filter on the data. Users can set the filter to a particular value or a range of values.



This allows users to group data on specific criteria such as state, library type, etc.



This allows the user to calculate aggregate statistics based on the entire dataset, filtered data, or grouped data.



This allows the user to chart variables against each other. The user can select from Pie, Bar, Line, Spline, or Scatter Plot charts.



By choosing this icon, users can perform crosstabs to explore relationships between the data.



The user can also determine how many records are displayed per page by clicking on this icon.






National Five Year Trends for Circulation per Capita






National Five Year Trends for Circulation per Capita

Line Chart




National Five Year Trends for Circulation per Capita

Stacked Bar Chart





Stacked Area Chart




National Five Year Trends for Circulation per Capita








